Application may be hand written or typed using 10-12 point reader friendly font. Include your name at the top of each page. This will be judged on the following criteria: Size and Scope of Project (10 points); Purpose, Goals & Plans for the Future (15 points); Management (20 points); Achievement (20 points); Leadership (20 points); Clarity, Thoroughness of Answers and Neatness of Application (15 points). E-mail or mail your completed application to either of the addresses listed above.

- 2. How and when did you get started in your project? Who has helped you the most with this project?
- 3. What are your goals this year for your project?
- 4. List your membership in all rabbit related organizations. Include the name of clubs and number of years that you have been a member of each club.
- 5. What offices have you held or committees have you served on in local, state or national rabbit clubs?
- 6. Name the varieties of Netherland Dwarfs that you have raised. Which is your favorite variety and why?
- 7. Describe your housing, equipment and herd management. Be specific.
- 8. What specifically do you do to help with the care and upkeep of your project?
- 9. Describe the records you keep and how you keep them.
- 10. List the outstanding awards and achievements that your Netherland Dwarf rabbits have earned.
- 11. List the outstanding awards and achievements that you have earned with this project.
- 12. What have you done to promote the Netherland Dwarf as a breed and make others aware of your project?
- 13. How have you been a leader in your project?
- 14. How do you think that your project will help you in your future endeavors?
- 15. What would you like for us to know that has not already been asked?
- 16. On a separate page write a short description of your achievements that can be printed in the *Dwarf Digest,* if you win this contest. Write what you would like to be printed in 400 words or less. *This does not count toward the page count, but failure to included this question will result in a 20 point deduction in the application score*.
